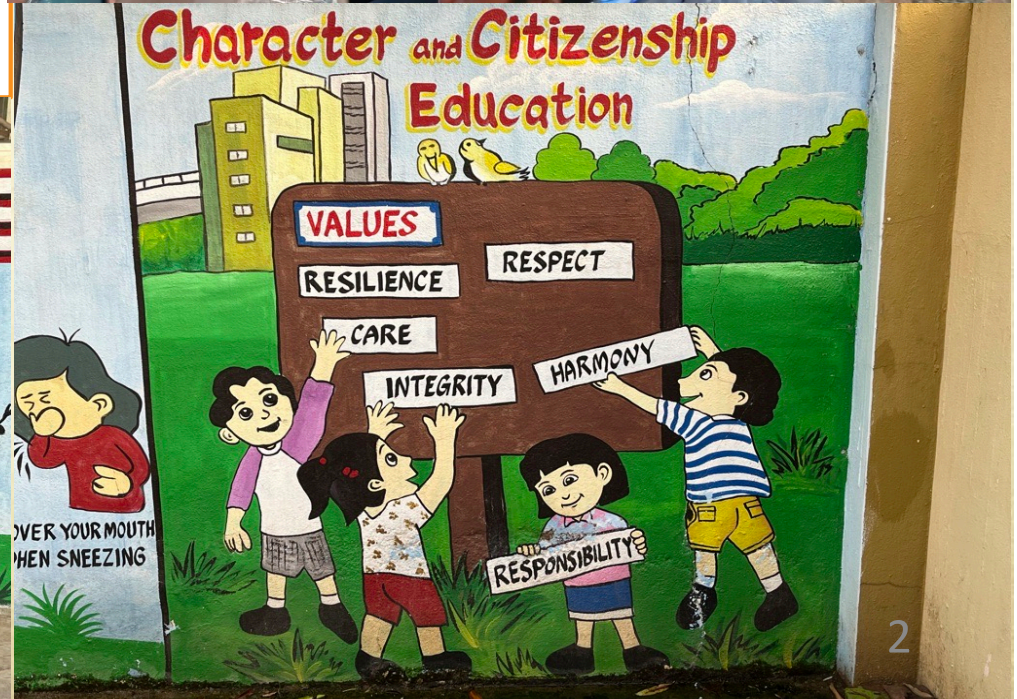

Education In Global English Medium School

Education is essential for the holistic development of children in India. It plays a critical role in their physical, mental, emotional, and social development. Education helps children to learn to be independent, develop a sense of responsibility, and become productive members of society.

In India, the education system is divided into two tiers, pre-primary and primary. Pre-primary education is structured to teach children basic skills such as counting, reading, and writing.

Primary education is designed to build on these skills, and prepare children for higher education and their future career. Child education in India is of utmost importance and is widely stressed upon. It is considered to be one of the most important investments in a nation's human capital, and is a key factor in the growth and development of any nation.

Whereas children from the higher casts are “well nurtured” and well educated, parents from the lower and lowest cast (income per family 80-100 USD/month) are often unable to pay the fees, even for the state schools in the villages.

ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL IS IMPORTANT IN INDIA'S SCHOOL EDUCATION



Although the State of India “guarantees” to provide access to education to every child, reality is different. Mainly parents from the upper casts are economically able to send their children to good and often very expensive schools.

All courses and jobs after school education will be In English so children who do not know English will be almost without progress in career or to continue Higher Education.

GLOBAL ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL is started to make it possible that children from weaker section of society also can get EDUCATION IN ENGLISH MEDIUM to reach their goals and to break the poverty line from their family.



INDIA— a Traditionally infinitely rich and materially desperately poor country

GLOBAL ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL teaches about 600 children from Lower Kinder Garden to grade 10. Mainly female teachers teach at salaries which are slightly lower than those in state schools. They are convinced that teacher's and children's access for all religions is vital.*

All teachers look after the children as if they were their own. Children come from 40 villages within a radius of 20-30 km with leased buses and drivers. Buses and drivers are provided by the school free of charge since otherwise children could/would not come to school.

*Approximately 40% of the teachers are Christians, 50% Hindus, 10% Muslims. The same applies to the children. The head of the school (principal) is 49 years old. He has been a teacher for 23 years in college and joined 4 years ago.
