Project Objectives

- 1. **Improve Academic Performance**: Offer tutoring in Mathematics, English, Science, and foundational literacy skills.
- 2. **Foster a Supportive Environment**: Create a safe, welcoming space for focused learning.
- 3. **Encourage Community Participation**: Involve parents and local stakeholders in supporting children's education.

Location and Renovation Requirements

The center will be located in a vacant building in Ponangi. The following renovations are essential:

- **Electrical Installation**: Ensure safe and functional wiring for lighting and educational tools.
- **Roof Repairs**: Address minor roof damages for a safe environment.

• **Washroom Renovations**: Upgrade two existing washrooms and build two additional facilities to meet student needs.

Implementation Plan

1. Renovation Phase

- o Timeline: 3 weeks
- o Engage local workers to complete electrical, roofing, and washroom renovations.

2. Furniture Procurement

- o **Timeline**: 1 week after renovations
- o Purchase student chairs and tables from local suppliers.

3. Teacher Recruitment

- o **Timeline**: 1 month before classes start
- o Hire qualified teachers through community outreach and advertising.

4. Launching the Center

- o **Timeline**: 1 month after furnishing
- o Host an inauguration to foster community involvement.

- 2. **Increased Confidence**: Students develop motivation and self-assurance through consistent learning support.
